The Marshall House is the sole building surviving from the Battles of Saratoga. Taken by the British to serve as a hospital and shelter for women and children traveling with the royal army, the horrendous events that occurred here were famously recorded by Baroness Frederika Riedesel, wife of Major General Riedesel, commander of the German forces hired by the British. The baroness is dramatically impersonated by actress Debbie Bailey.

Artifacts are exhibited. Visitors are invited to go down into the storied stone cellar. Bloodstains on the floor are shown.

A free-will donation of \$10 per adult is welcome. Children free. Money received is used by The Marshall House, Inc., a New York State educational corporation to preserve this one-of-a-kind historic property.
